***Resolution to Recommend Approval of the RME to Eliminate the
Fibers/Weaving Specialization from the Art Major in the
School of Art and Design***

WHEREAS Fibers/Weaving is a specialization in the Bachelor of Arts degree curriculum in the School of Art and Design within the College of Liberal Arts; and

WHEREAS there have been no students in the Fibers/Weaving specialization or Fibers/Weaving courses taught since Spring, 2001; and

WHEREAS due to retirement there are no faculty specializing in the Fibers/Weaving area in the School; and

WHEREAS the department, in discussion with the Director of the School of Art and Design and the Dean of the College of Liberal Arts, has decided not to fill the faculty line in Fibers/Weaving, but rather replace it with a faculty member in the Design area;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Faculty Senate recommend the RME calling for the elimination of the Fibers/Weaving Specialization from the Art Major in the School of Art and Design.
