Resolution to Recommend the Approval of the RME to Eliminate the Industrial Design Specialization from the Bachelor of Arts Degree in the School of Art and Design

WHEREAS Industrial Design is a specialization in both the Bachelor of Arts and the Bachelor of Fine Arts degrees in the School of Art and Design within the College of Liberal Arts; and

WHEREAS the Bachelor of Fine Arts Degree is the preferred degree and there are no students currently enrolled in the Industrial Design specialization of the Bachelor of Arts degree; and

WHEREAS the School of Art and Design wishes to consolidate the two industrial design specializations into one program, the BFA in art, industrial design specialization;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Faculty Senate recommend the RME calling for the elimination of the Industrial Design Specialization from the Bachelor of Art Degree in the School of Art and Design.
