***Resolution to Recommend an Earlier Deadline
for Graduation Applications***

WHEREAS current graduation application procedures result in late application processing, late graduation clearances from advisement units, and late degree postings; and

WHEREAS the current deadline of Friday of week one of the desired semester of graduation makes it difficult for students to enroll in courses in which they are deficient for graduation; and

WHEREAS if the graduation deadline was moved to the semester before the desired date of graduation, graduation checks could be performed, and students could enroll in deficient courses; and

WHEREAS such graduation checks should be performed before enrollment starts for the semester of desired graduation;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Faculty Senate recommend that a new deadline for Graduation Applications be instituted no later than the end of the 4th week of the semester prior to the anticipated graduation date.
